

# Phi Beta Lambda Corporate Casual Dress Code Guidelines

## **Female**

### **Acceptable:**

- Dresses, vests, shirts, blouses, turtlenecks, or sweaters (with modest necklines)
- Sport or polo shirts
- Dress shoes, sandals, loafers or other casual shoes
- Pants
- Capri pants (no denim or cargo pants)

### **Unacceptable:**

- Jeans or denim material pants
- Jean capri pants or denim material capri pants
- Stretch pants, cargo pants (or pants with several pockets), hip-hugger pants with short tops, and walking shorts
- Clothing exposing bare back or midriff and spaghetti-strap tops
- Sweatshirts, sweatpants, and t-shirts
- Tight-fitting clothing or spandex
- Athletic shoes
- White athletic socks
- Extremely casual sandals and shower shoes (i.e. foam shoes with no heel)

## **Male**

### **Acceptable:**

- Sport or polo shirts
- Button-up shirts (tucked in)
- Loafers or other casual shoes
- Pants or slacks

### **Unacceptable:**

- Jeans
- Denim material pants, cargo pants (or pants with several pockets), and walking shorts
- Tight-fitting clothing or spandex
- Sweatshirts, sweatpants, and t-shirts
- Athletic shoes
- White athletic socks
- Sandals

PBL members are expected to be personally clean and well groomed. Clothing must be clean, neat, and pressed.

PBL members are not permitted to wear jewelry in visible body piercing other than ears.
